## A Paleoindian (ca. 8,500 BC) to Middle Woodland (800 AD) Chronology

The Prehistoric Beech Ridge site preserved a remarkable stratigraphic soil sequence where classic late Paleoindian through Middle Woodland projectile point types were recovered. Of note is a Paleoindian Dalton-Hardaway specimen recovered from the A/B Soil Horizon.
