There have been some grammatical corrections made to the Process for Letter of No Contention (LONC)/Permit for Entrance Construction (PEC) Requests guidelines. These changes will essentially help improve the comprehension of what is required for project approval.

The DelDOT Notes have been changed as well. The General Notes document that was comprised of Construction/Entrance Plans, Record/Site Plans and Maintenance of Traffic notes has now been divided in to individual documents. This will allow us to make more unequivocal changes that will pertain to each of these subjects and make these updates more coherent.

Please note: there was a change made in the Maintenance of Traffic notes (item number 25) regarding permanent advancement warning roadway signs. Previously, warning signs were to be installed at 1500, 1000, and 500 feet in advance of the work area in both directions. We are reducing that to warning signs with the legends "Road Work Ahead" in advancement in both directions.
