


### FY2016 - Sources of Funds - \$856.8M

## **Borrowing Strategy**


\$150 million in new borrowing over 6 years

### Borrowing Plan Still Reduces Debt



### **Other Reforms**

- \$5M of DelDOT Operating to the General Fund
- Creating a "Lock Box" on the TTF (SB166, SB167)
  - Capital Expenditures on the public transportation system
  - Payments to debt service
  - Other transportation related purposes
  - Revenue generated by HB 140 can only be used on the capital program
- Project Prioritization Process
- Continue Debt Service Management
- Continue Implementing Operating Efficiencies

# Impact to FY 16 CTP (Authorization)

- Increase in State of Good Repair
  - Paving Program additional \$45M
  - Bridge Preservation additional \$5M
- Increase in Community Transportation Funds
  - \$8,375,000 to \$16,750,000
- Increase in Municipal Street Aid
  - \$3M to \$5M
- Delayed Capital Projects Advance (see handout)
  - \$22M

# Draft FY 17-22 CTP Modifications

- Projects moved into the Statewide Program
  - US 13 from South Court Street to Loockerman Street
  - N209, Grubb Road, SR 261, Foulk Road to SR 92, Naaman's Road, Pedestrian Improvements
  - SR 10/Lebanon Road, St. Jones to Brecknock Park Multi Use Path
