Dear Sirs:

The Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) is requesting Interim Approval for the optional use of the Traffic Signal Photo Enforced Sign (R10-18a) on approaches to signalized intersections where photo enforcement of the red traffic signal indication is in use on state maintained roadways. This request for Interim Approval is in regards to the FHWA Interim Approval, IA-12, that was released on November 12, 2010.

DelDOT currently has thirty (30) locations statewide where traffic signal photo enforcement cameras are in use. A list of these locations can be found at the following website, <a href="http://www.deldot.gov/information/red\_light/">http://www.deldot.gov/information/red\_light/</a>. It is anticipated that the R10-18a sign will be used at each of these locations and any additional locations where traffic signal photo enforcement cameras may be installed in the future. DelDOT agrees to abide by the specific conditions for the use of the R10-18a sign as contained in the FHWA's Interim Approval, IA-12. DelDOT agrees to maintain and continually update a list of locations where the R10-18a sign has been installed. Finally, DelDOT agrees to restore the sites of the interim approval to a condition that complies with the provisions in the MUTCD within three (3) months following the issuance of a final rule on this traffic control device and terminate use of the R10-18a sign installed under the interim approval at any time that DelDOT determines significant safety concerns are directly or indirectly attributable to the device or application.
