

ABSTRACT

This cultural resources documentation for the Blue Ball Master Plan project area was undertaken by archeologists and historians with John Milner Associates, Inc. The study included review of previous cultural resources investigations in the vicinity of the project area and a summary of the results of those investigations. A discussion of the prehistoric and historic background of the project area is included. In the last thirty years numerous cultural resource surveys have been conducted within or near the Blue Ball Master Plan project area. To date, seventeen individual cultural resources have been identified, including three standing structures, a bridge, a milestone, and twelve archeological sites. Recommendations for additional archeological investigations at previously identified sites are presented, as are recommendations for Phase I surveys of areas not subjected to previous surveys.
