

ABSTRACT

The Cultural Resource Group of Louis Berger & Associates, Inc. (Berger), conducted an architectural National Register evaluation survey along North Street from Mifflin Road to West Street in Dover for the Delaware Department of Transportation. Architectural investigation inventoried a total of nine individual resources and one potential historic district containing resources over 50 years of age. One resource, Eden Hill (K-125), has been listed in the National Register of Historic Places. The Delaware State Historic Preservation Office (DE SHPO) has preliminarily identified a neighborhood in West Dover, a portion of which lies within this project's area of potential effect, as potentially eligible for the National Register as a historic district (K-6972). The district includes three individual resources documented in this study, all of which have been determined significant contributing elements to the district. Berger recommends that the eastern boundaries for the district be expanded to incorporate two additional surveyed resources that contribute to the district. The remaining three resources surveyed are located outside the district and do not meet National Register of Historic Places criteria.
