The building was a stuccoed masonry dwelling with wood frame ell, associated with the large agricultural holdings of the Clark family north of Glasgow known as "Clarksdale"; it was scheduled for demolition at the time of the completion of the previous survey form in 1987, and recommended not eligible at that time.

This property had been assigned a survey number; however, no form was found on file either at the Delaware State Historic Preservation Office or at the New Castle County Planning Department. No properties with the given address appear in New Castle County tax records; it appears likely that the property stood on the corner lot (parcel #1101300051, listed as 1528 S. College Avenue) that is now vacant and owned by the state of Delaware. A field check in August 2005 confirmed that no structure is standing in the location marked on the SPO map. A house still stands on the neighboring parcel to the west (1115 Old Baltimore Pike).


