Brook Ramble - Crawford House is listed in the National Register of Historic Places. The property is identified as the Crawford residence on the Rea and Price 1849 map and G.W. Baist 1893 map. Property appears as the J.V. Crawford residence, also known as "Brook Ramble," on the Beers 1868 map. The dwelling sustained minor damage as a result of a recent fire. The National Register eligible George Brady Farm Manager's Dwelling (N05216) has been relocated to the tax parcel located immediately southwest of Brook Ramble.

A property appears at the location of the present dwelling on the 1849 Rea and Price map, 1868 Beers map, 1893 Baist map, and 1931 Smyrna, DE U.S.G.S. map. The property is identified with W. Ginn in 1849 and 1868 and Benjamin Ginn in 1893. The previous survey form (1980) incorrectly identified the property as a one-story Cape Cod style dwelling constructed ca. 1920. NCC Tax Data information indicates the property was constructed ca. 1880. Based on field investigations, the property appears to be a late nineteenth century frame dwelling.


