There are no CRS forms for this property in the DESHPO. Historic accounts (Reynolds 1982:366) suggest that there was a gas station on this lot, but the CRS form for K-2724 says that lot contained "Conley Hardware". The USGS map from 1956 (photorevised 1982; Frederica Quadrangle) show a large building (probably this one) and a smaller one nearer to the road, which was probably the gas station and/or "Conley Hardware".
