33 nineteenth-century artifacts were concentrated in the northwestern corner of the agricultural field to the north of the Hart Farm house. Identified as Locus 1, these artifacts may be associated with two houses shown on an 1883 Orphans Court plat of the Thomas Hart Estate. This locus has been tentatively identified as the Hart Tenant Farm site.

A lesser concentration of historic artifacts, Locus 2, occurs in the middle of the agricultural field and is likely field scatter associated with the Hart Farm site.



7. FEATURES:

Topsoil was removed in two gradall trenches excavated within a narrow strip along Cedar Grove Road in conjunction with Intersection Improvements for Plantation Road and Cedar Grove Road. Ten features were documented, five in Trench 1 and five in Trench 2. No burial shafts were noted, and none of the features were excavated.

Feature 1 was a possible heart, Features 2, 3, 4, 7-9 were possible post holes; Feature 5 was a possible refuse pit; Feature 6 was unidentified but appeared to be related to road disturbance; and Feature 10 was a series of 7 stains in a row that were interpreted to be a former tree line.




