

SUMMARY OF FINDINGS

This report presents the results of a historic resource survey and determination of eligibility undertaken to identify and describe above-ground structures 50 years old or older for the School Bell Road (State Route [S.R.] 1 to U.S. 40) Improvements project in New Castle Hundred, New Castle County, Delaware.

Research indicated that one previously surveyed historic resource, the Ashton House (N-1598), occurs within the project Area of Potential Effects (APE). The survey identified five additional above-ground resources built prior to 1954 within the APE. The evaluation of their potential eligibility for listing in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP), using the NRHP Criteria for Evaluation and state guidelines, determined that none of the resources are eligible for inclusion in the NRHP.
