**Topics Discussed:**

I met with Lu Ann DeCunzo to discuss areas of high archaeological sensitivity within the APE for the Washington Street sidewalks project. Dr. DeCunzo stated that no previous investigations have been completed in this section of New Castle and that there is very little information available on archaeological sensitivity. She indicated that the stratigraphy of the area is unknown and that she was not aware of any archaeological sites that have been reported or are known to members of the local community. Dr. DeCunzo agreed with Ned and Louise Heite's assessment that there is a potential for archaeological sites to be sealed under fill deposits in the South Street portion of the APE. Dr. DeCunzo and I discussed construction monitoring as a strategy to investigate portions of the APE where ground surface is not accessible but where deeply buried archaeological sites may exist. She agreed that shovel testing is limited by the percentage of the APE paved for existing sidewalks, drives and parking lots.
