PUBLIC WORKSHOPS
DISADVANTAGED BUSINESS ENTERPRISE
PROGRAM PARTICIPATION GOAL FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR (FFY) 2017-2019

In accordance with 49 CFR Part 26, the Delaware Department of Transportation (DelDOT) has established a proposed overall goal of 13.8% Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (DBE) participation on federal aid contracts during FFY 2017 through FFY 2019. The goal includes a race-neutral participation goal of 2.2%. The public is advised that the information on the methodology used to develop this goal is available for review during normal business hours (8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m., Monday - Friday) or online at www.dbe.deldot.gov until the close of business day July 31, 2016.

DelDOT will also hold several public workshops to allow the public to review and comment on the proposed goal. These workshops will be held as follows:
