PUBLIC WORKSHOP SUMMARY

Proposed Route Designation Changes – DE Route 41 and DE Route 2 April 6, 2015 – May 15, 2015 Virtual Public Workshop

A virtual public workshop was held on April 6, 2015 through May 15, 2015 using *Survey Monkey* to solicit public feedback regarding the Department's proposal to unbraided DE Route 41 and DE Route 2 along Kirkwood Highway between the DE Route 41 intersection and DE Route 141 interchange. The survey asked two questions:

1. Please comment below if you are in favor of DelDOT's proposal to eliminate the overlapping of state routes 2 and 41 along Kirkwood Highway. If you are not in favor of this proposal, please provide reasons why for the Department's consideration.
2. Please provide any additional information that would be helpful to DelDOT for consideration of this proposal.

A total of 49 responses to the survey were received with all 49 respondents responding to Question 1 and 30 respondents provided responses to Question 2. All 49 respondents were in favor of the proposed route designation changes. Below is a summary of the additional comments received.

Summary of Comments from Question 1:

- The majority of respondents leaving additional comments noted that they would like trucks restricted from DE Route 41.
- Several respondents mentioned speeding is a concern along DE Route 41.
- One respondent noted that the current signage is confusing to people not familiar with the area.
- Consider other options to assist in easing the truck traffic on DE Route 41 such as directing the trucks to DE Route 48, which was specifically widened for the purpose of being able to properly handle the truck weight and contain less residential areas located so closely to the road.

Summary of Comments from Question 2:

- A suggestion was made to modify the pull through sign on OH-4 (SO 1-140-006) instead of completely removing it. The suggestion was to replace the existing sign with a sign noting a designation and providing the same pull through information (SR 141)
- One respondent noted that similar truck traffic concerns existing on SR 7 between SR 2 and the PA state line.
- Designate SR 48 as the route to Lancaster.
