Bayard Square Civic Association has partnered with the City of Wilmington and Delaware Department of Transportation for the design and construction of the Bayard Square Enhancements Project. This project is under the Federal Transportation Enhancement Program.

Project Description:

The proposed project consists of replacing existing sidewalk with a combined brick pavers and concrete sidewalk along Lincoln Street from Sycamore Street to Linden Street. Brick paver “neck downs” and improved handicap ramps will be constructed at the intersections. This project will promote traffic calming and improve pedestrian safety in the community. Construction is estimated to begin in the Fall 2012.
