

# **Bridge Demolition Notice (Pedestrians)**

**(week of 6/3/12 through 6/9/12)**

All pedestrian traveling under the existing bridge structure must pass through the protective shielding over the pathways on the north and south sides of the inlet channel. Pedestrians walking through shielded areas are requested not to stop or stand under the protective shielding for prolonged periods. All pedestrians should obey the instructions of construction personnel when present.

## **Daytime Work Activities (June 5<sup>th</sup> through June 9<sup>th</sup>)**

Pedestrians are advised that demolition crews will be removing concrete barrier and saw cutting on the existing bridge structure. When required, construction personnel will temporarily stop pedestrian traffic under the bridge. Daylight working hours are 6:00 AM to 6:00 PM.

## **Night time Work Activities (June 6<sup>th</sup> through June 8<sup>th</sup>)**

Pedestrians are advised that demolition crews will be removing concrete deck segments on the existing bridge structure. When required, construction personnel will temporarily stop pedestrian traffic under the bridge. Night time working hours are 8:00 PM to 6:00 AM.
