



## ROUTE 1 EXPANSION PROJECT

Please be patient as DelDOT  
“Opens Route 1 Up A Notch”

Road construction will occur  
from September 11, 2006 to Late Spring 2008  
including Summer 2007

on

Route 1 from Five Points Intersection to Route 24

This project will restore a dedicated travel lane  
and a shared use lane.



### MOTORISTS

- During construction, Route 1 from Five Points Intersection to Route 24 will be decreased from three to two travel lanes. This will create significant travel delays.
- Motorists should take alternate routes into and out of the beach area:
  - South: **Follow Route 1 south to the Milford Route 113/Route 1 Split. Take Route 113 south to Route 26 or Route 54 East. Continue east to the beach area.**
  - Northwest: **Route 24 West to Route 5 North**
  - Southwest: **Route 54 West to Route 113 North**

### BUSINESSES

- Access will be maintained to all businesses and residences along Route 1 during construction.
- DelDOT will provide signage to ensure motorists know where to access business entrances.



### CYCLISTS

- Cyclists should use Bike Route 1/Plantations Road as a safer, alternate route through the area.
- Cyclists may also wish to ride DART First State buses equipped with bike racks.
- If traveling through the work zone, we caution you to follow the rules of the road.  
(Drive with flow of traffic, wear bright reflective clothing, install bike lights, and always wear a helmet)



### PEDESTRIANS

- Where sidewalks currently exist, pedestrian access will be maintained during construction.
