### Veteran Identification (ID) Cards



Veteran Identification (ID) Cards are being issued by the Delaware Division of Motor Vehicles. This card is available to any Delaware veteran who served in the U.S. military and was honorably discharged. The cards are free of charge. To obtain a card, veterans must have a valid Delaware driver license or ID card and provide proof of military service, such as:

- Military ID
- DD-214

The veteran ID cards are designed to verify an individual as a veteran in the State of Delaware, so that businesses can opt to recognize the contributions of those veterans who have faithfully served our country and represented our great state.

The veteran ID cards can be obtained at all DMV locations. Scheduled appointments are preferred, but walk-in appointments are accepted.

To schedule an appointment, please call Dover DMV at (302) 744-2515, Georgetown at (302) 853-1005, Wilmington DMV at (302) 434-3203, or Delaware City DMV at (302) 832-5176. Hours of operation are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 8:00 AM to 4:30 PM; Wednesday from noon to 8:00 PM.

Please note that this card is not a military ID card and does not entitle veterans to all military benefits.

## Delaware Transit Corporation

The Delaware Transit Corporation (DTC), a division of the Delaware Department of Transportation, operates DART. As Delaware's statewide public transportation provider, DART services include fixed route, intercounty, seasonal bus, paratransit, contracted SEPTA commuter trains, and RideShare Delaware's ridematching program.



DART services may be an option for you, in addition to the resources listed in this brochure. DART bus stops are in close walking distance to the Wilmington VA Medical Center on Kirkwood Highway and Community Based Outpatient Clinics (CBOC) in Kent and Sussex Counties.

DART statewide Paratransit Services offer comparable transportation for individuals with disabilities who are unable to use regular bus service. An application and approval process is required.



**Did You Know?**  
You may be eligible to pay a **Reduced Fare** on DART's regular bus service.

Reduced fares are for people who are age 65 & over, or who have a certified disability.

When paying reduced fares, customers must either show the bus operator a Medicare Card, or present a DART Reduced Fare Photo ID.
