

Introduction

The Project Status Report includes all active capital transportation projects that have been initiated for work activities to begin within the Department of Transportation from the date of inception until the project as acceptance well as a report of completed (accepted) projects. The Project Status files are updated daily and the Report is currently available via the Internet on a monthly basis.

The following information is offered as explanations for the data in the reports:

<u>Project No.</u>	A seven digit number assigned to a given work description at a specified location(s).
<u>Project Title</u>	Authorized name of the work to be accomplished. This is the project initiation title and the "official" name of the project.
<u>Fed Aid No.</u>	Assigned federal-aid project number, if applicable.
<u>Description</u>	Description of the type of work to be accomplished on the project.
<u>PS&E Cmpl.</u>	Month and year in which the plans, specifications, and estimate are completed.
<u>Advertised</u>	Month, day, and year on which the project is advertised for construction phase.
<u>Bids Rcvd.</u>	Month, day, and year on which the bids were accepted by Contract Administration.
<u>Tot Proj Cost</u>	The estimated total project costs for all phases of this project, including preliminary engineering, right of way acquisition and relocation, construction, construction engineering, utilities, and traffic. Projects that have not yet reached the construction phase are indicated by a range of estimated costs. Once the project is awarded, the range will be changed to the actual estimated total project cost.
<u>Date Awarded</u>	Month, day, and year on which the project was awarded to the contractor.
<u>Contractor</u>	Name of contractor awarded the project.
<u>Est. Cmpl.</u>	Approximate date when the project should be complete.
<u>Final Insp.</u>	The month, day, and year on which the final inspection is held.
<u>Bid Amt.</u>	The dollar amount of the award (rounded to the nearest dollar).

Additional comments regarding the project that are not specified above.

There are two indexes preceding the active projects' report. The first is a complete alphabetical listing of the project titles with the corresponding project number, district and page number. Those projects that appear with an asterisk (*) next to the project number have been awarded for construction. The second is an alphabetical listing of authorized locations under the Community Transportation Fund that have been initiated as projects. This index also includes the corresponding project number, district and page number.

The index preceding the completed projects report is an alphabetical listing of projects within the completed projects report which contains all projects accepted as complete or deactivated during the time period specified.

Both the active and the completed reports are separated into three sections:

- 1) North District - includes projects in New Castle County that are north of the Chesapeake and Delaware (C&D) Canal.
- 2) Central District - includes projects in New Castle County that are south of the C & D Canal and all those in Kent County.
- 3) South District - includes projects in Sussex County.

Within each district, the projects are listed in numerical order, first by the middle three digits identifying the type and location of work to be done, then by the first two digits indicating the year the project was initiated, and finally by the last two digits indicating the sequential numbering based on the type of work to be done. The following list lists the project numbers and the corresponding project type.
