Process for Electronic Payments

The Department of Transportation, Development Coordination Section implemented procedural changes in 2015 requiring all fees related to Land Development, Subdivision Projects, and Entrances be submitted electronically through the Planning Development Coordination Application (PDCA) (http://pdca.deldot.gov/).

These fee types include, but are not limited to:

- Initial Stage Fee
- Construction Stage Fee
- Area Wide Study Fee
- Shared-Use Path (SUP) & Sidewalk Fee
- Traffic Impact Study Option B
- Contributions to Road Improvements
- Contributions to DelDOT Capital Projects
- Traffic Signal Revolving Fund

When submitting a payment, choose the appropriate fee type for the payment being made. If choosing 'Other' to submit a payment for any of the below fee types, the Project Names, Road/Intersection Name, State Contract Numbers pertaining to the payment should be included and, if applicable, what # of payment is being submitted:

- Contributions to Offsite Improvements.
- Contributions to Capital Transportation Program projects
- Traffic Signal Revolving Fund
