



DEPRESSED CORNER WITH SHARED TURNING SPACE



CORNER BLENDED TRANSTION WITH SIDEWALK


NOTES:

- 1). SEE C-2, SHEET 1 FOR GENERAL PEDESTRIAN CONNECTION NOTES AND ELEMENT REQUIREMENTS.
- PERPENDICULAR AND PARALLEL RAMP CONFIGURATIONS ARE PREFERRED TO DEPRESSED 2). CORNERS. DEPRESSED CORNERS SHOULD ONLY BE USED WHERE SITE CONDITIONS MAKE THEM A MORE APPROPRIATE OPTION, OR WHERE PERPENDICULAR OR PARALLEL RAMPS CANNOT BE INSTALLED DUE TO A PHYSICAL SITE CONSTRAINT. SEE THE CURRENT DELDOT PAS MANUAL FOR ADDITIONAL INFORMATION.
- 3). A TURNING SPACE IS NOT REQUIRED AT THE TOP OF THE RAMP WHEN NO TURNING MOVEMENT IS REQUIRED TO ENTER OR EXIT THE RAMP.
