## REPRESENTATIVE EXPERIENCE

Ms. Brockett has four years of experience in historic building research and documentation, particularly in the Mid-Atlantic and Pacific Northwest regions. She has specific knowledge of the history of Maryland and Virginia, with a variety of research projects in this area at the local, state and national levels. Projects have included intensive and reconnaissance level architectural surveys, National Register nominations, Determinations of Eligibility, Historic American Buildings Survey (HABS) research and documentation, and extensive historical research.

Representative examples of Ms. Brockett's experience include the following:

**National Register Determinations of Eligibility, MARC Maintenance Facility, Baltimore, Maryland, 2001.** Five buildings were evaluated for their eligibility for inclusion in the National Register. Included are several mid-century warehouses and businesses, an early 20<sup>th</sup> century car dealership, and a White Tower restaurant.

**Historic Streetscape Studies, Galena and Greensboro, Maryland, 2001.** Streetscapes in these two historic Eastern Shore towns were surveyed for historic buildings, sidewalk, lawn, and street features as a preliminary study for streetscape improvements.

**National Register Historic District Determination of Eligibility, Sykesville, Maryland, 2001.** The South Branch Recreational Area was evaluated for its potential eligibility for inclusion in the National Register for the Howard County Department of Recreation and Parks. Above-ground historic resources include a late 19<sup>th</sup> century stone dwelling, an early 20<sup>th</sup> century water tower, a truck scale, and brick warehouse.

**HABS Recordation, Hilden-Halifax Mill, South Boston, Virginia, 2001.** A full history and physical descriptions were prepared to accompany professional HABS quality photographs for this extensive late 19<sup>th</sup> and early 20<sup>th</sup> century cotton mill complex. The complex included cotton houses, weaving, spinning, and storage buildings, as well as an office, and numerous support facilities, such as the boiler house, reservoirs, and railroad siding.

**Historic Building Documentation, St. Louis Airport vicinity, Missouri, 2000.** Eight buildings were documented through photography, measured floorplans, and completion of

intensive level survey forms. A context statement on the towns of Bridgeton and Hazelwood, Missouri was also completed. A marketing package was prepared to locate buyers and inform them of building relocation strategies. A public education poster and brochures on the historic buildings and towns were also designed and distributed.

**Historic Structure Report, Fort Garrison, Baltimore County, Maryland, 2000.** A report documenting the history, construction, and materials of this small stone building was prepared for the Baltimore County Department of Recreation and Parks. The report also includes measured elevation and floorplan drawings and recommendations for repair and maintenance.

**Historic Buildings Survey, Princeville, North Carolina, 2000.** A survey of 84 buildings over 50 years of age was completed for the Federal Emergency Management Agency. The town of Princeville was founded soon after Emancipation by freed slaves. The town was also studied for its potential eligibility for the National Register both for individual building listings and as a historic district.

**HABS Recordation of the Virginia Shipbuilding Corporation Administration Building, Alexandria, Virginia, 2000.** A full building history and physical description were prepared to accompany professional HABS quality photographs for the last remaining building at this World War I Emergency Fleet Corporation shipyard.

**HABS Recordation of the U.S. Army Signal Corps Generator Building, Alexandria, Virginia, 2000.** A full building history and physical description were prepared to accompany professional HABS-quality photographs of a Signal Corps generator building. This generator was used to provide power to a WWII and Korean War UHF transmitter in Alexandria, Virginia.

**Cemetery Restoration Plan, Oakview Cemetery, Albany, Georgia, 2000.** A detailed cemetery restoration plan was prepared for FEMA for the National Register-eligible Oakview Cemetery. This cemetery sustained substantial damage during 1996 floods. The plan provides both technical advice and a discussion of the planning process for a cemetery restoration project.

**National Register Determination of Eligibility Form for Former Baltimore Transit Company Facility Buildings, 2000.** A National Register Determination of Eligibility with

complete building histories and descriptions was prepared for buildings at 1300 Bush Street in Baltimore, MD. Buildings include a former office, cafeteria, and locker room for employees of Baltimore's major streetcar company.

**Cultural Resources Assessment, Fort Buchanan, San Juan, Puerto Rico, 2000.** A summary of historic architectural resources was prepared for the Army and Air Force Exchange Service in preparation for constructing a new Community Center on the base of Fort Buchanan.

**Investigation of Woodrow Wilson Bridge Wetland Mitigation Sites, Virginia, 2000.** Nineteen potential wetland creation sites were researched and examined to determine effects on potentially eligible historic properties. This project was completed for the Federal Highway Administration and submitted to the Virginia SHPO.

**National Register Determination of Eligibility Forms for Randallstown Elementary School and Former Health Clinic, Randallstown, Maryland, 1999.** National Register Determination of Eligibility Forms were prepared for these two buildings for Baltimore County Public Schools in November 1999. Research was conducted at the Baltimore County Courthouse, Department of Planning, School Administration Headquarters, and during site visits.

**Survey of George Washington University Buildings and Surrounding Areas, Washington DC, 1999.** Photographic and written survey forms were prepared for all George Washington University campus buildings and representative buildings in the surrounding Foggy Bottom neighborhood. An analysis was conducted to determine the impact of the University's presence within the National Register historic district surrounding the university.

**Reconnaissance Survey of Forest Service Buildings in Wind River National Forest, Wind River, Washington, 1999.** A survey of 1920s and 1930s buildings, including residential, organizational, and industrial structures, was conducted for the U.S. Forest Service to evaluate their architectural presence in the state of Washington.

**Intensive Surveys of the Olde Towne Residential Historic District, Portsmouth, Virginia, 1998.** Site surveys, photography, and historic research were conducted on this affluent residential area for the Virginia SHPO. Houses and outbuildings range in construction dates and styles from 1776

through the 1920s.

**HABS Field Drawings for Timberline Lodge, Mt. Hood, Oregon, 1998.** Field measurements and drawings on this National Historic Landmark ski lodge, built by the WPA in the early 1930s. Work included measuring and sketching all hotel rooms, public areas, service areas, and facilities.

**Preservation Plan for the Shelton-McMurphey-Johnson House, Oregon, 1998.** This plan was developed to provide for the preservation and long-term management of an 1888 Victorian house museum. The proposal, which has since been implemented, created a partnership among the City of Eugene (property owner), the Friends of Shelton-McMurphey-Johnson House (non-profit caretakers), and students in the University of Oregon's Historic Preservation Program. The house will continue operation as a house museum and will be used as a hands-on training facility for preservation students.

**Condition Assessment Report for Hope Abbey Mausoleum, Eugene, Oregon, 1997.** This report was prepared to provide an analysis of a failing concrete building in Eugene, Oregon. The report documented the history and construction of the building and detailed the steps necessary to effectively solve water infiltration problems. Copies were distributed to the City of Eugene (property owner) and the Friends of the Masonic Cemetery (non-profit caretakers).
