GUIDE TO ATTACHMENT VI

PRE-1802 SENSITIVITY ZONES

This appendix lists the major historic sensitivity zones for the pre-1802 period. These zones are mapped on 7.5' USGS maps in Attachment VI.

Saint Georges Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Major transpeninsular road (central route); Route 13.
- Zone 2: Lower Saint Georges Creek area; land between Dragon Creek and Scott Run.
- Zone 3: Headwaters area of major streams and their tributaries.
- Zone 4: Major transpeninsular road (western route); Routes 71 and 301.
- Zone 5: Secondary east-west connector road.

Middletown Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Major transpeninsular road (central route); Route 13.
- Zone 2: Mid-drainage and headwaters areas of major streams and their tributaries.
- Zone 3: Major transpeninsular road (western route); Routes 71, 301.
- Zone 4: Secondary east-west connector road; connecting both overland and water routes.

Taylor's Bridge Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Marshland of major streams; first available well-drained land along the lower reaches of major stream.

Clayton Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Major transpeninsular road (central route); Route 13
- Zone 2: Headwaters area of major streams and their tributaries.

Smyrna Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Major transpeninsular road (central route); Route 13.
- Zone 2: Mid-drainage areas of major streams and their tributaries.

Dover Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Major transpeninsular road (central route); Route 13
- Zone 2: Mid-drainage and headwaters areas of major streams and their tributaries.
- Zone 3: Junction of major overland and water transportation routes.

Kenton Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Headwaters-upper drainage areas of major stream and tributaries; western edge of settlement in Kent County.

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Little Creek Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Major transpeninsular road (eastern route); Route 9.
- Zone 2: Lower to mid-drainage area of major stream; locus of major overland and water transportation routes.

Wyoming Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Headwaters area of major streams and their tributaries; junction of water and overland routes.
- Zone 2: Upper and mid-drainage areas, headwater areas of principal streams and their tributaries.

Frederica Quadrangle

- Zone 1: Major transpeninsular road (central route); Route 13
- Zone 2: Lower to mid-drainage areas of major streams and tributaries; first area of well-drained land on major stream, marshland on lower reaches of river.
