9. OTHER NOTES OR OBSERVATIONS:

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This circa 1930 three bay machine shed storage barn is located on the west side of Cedar Creek Road nearly ¼ mile south of Wilkins Road. From another lot owned by the same property owner, a U-shape access way provides access to the structure. The machine shed barn measures approximately 50' by 40' and rest on a series of heavy timber post/trees (un-cut, stripped of bark and mechanically saw cut) set in the ground. The flooring is dirt. The central rafter support system is supported on a series of Queen Post. The roof framing consist of common sawed timbers. The building is sheathed in seamless metal sheets. The front gable is low pitched and the roof is covered in corrugated metal sheets. Sections of the roof are missing. Various farming equipments, but nothing of substantial interest would have been stored in the barn. Also evident on the lot is a circa 1930 front gable storage shed with a central wood panel entrance. The building measures approximately 8' by 12' and rest on concrete cinder blocks It was probably moved to its present location. The shed is sheathed in seamless metal sheets. The roof is covered in asphalt shingles. A large contemporary pole barn is located at the rear of the property. Like the two older barns it is used for storage.


