EVALUATION CRITERIA

Submissions will be evaluated using Pass/Fail determinations of: *(additional detail in RFQ)*

- A. Experience as Prime Integrator for at least one similar ORT project;
- B. Experience as Prime Integrator for at least one toll system project with at least 10 stop and go lanes in each direction, and has been in operation for at least one (1) year;
- C. Adequate business, managerial, and technical resources to meet the accelerated program to deploy this project on time.
- D. Acceptable (accredited preferred) Quality Management System (QMS) with examples of your use of the QMS to deliver toll system projects within schedule and budget.
- E. Financial statements for the last two (2) years showing gross revenue of at least \$5 million per year.
