

JFK Memorial Highway Improvement Program; SR1 / I-95 Interchange

OPEN MEETING - May 18, 2010

Interested construction inspection firms;

DelDOT anticipates advertising late in 2010 for construction inspection services specifically for this project.

DelDOT is finalizing plans for the SR1 / I-95 Interchange project which is the next phase of the JFK Memorial Highway Improvement Program.

This effort is part of a multi-year, multi-project Turnpike Improvement Program that has included work at Churchman' Road/SR 7 Intersection, the Churchman's Bridge over I-95; and the I-95 5th Lane Widening project.

The SR1 / I-95 Interchange project will add high speed connecting ramps from both Northbound SR1 to Northbound I-95 and from Southbound I-95 to Southbound SR1. The new ramps will tie into the recently completed I-95 5th Lane Widening Project. Construction is estimated to begin in early 2011. The implementation of the project is anticipated to be accomplished through 7 major phases of work on both SR1 and I-95. Additional information on the project and drawings of each phase are available on the project Website.
