



Coming to a Corner Near You...

The Delaware Department of Transportation (DeIDOT) is installing new pedestrian signals at various intersections throughout the state featuring a “countdown to safety.” This countdown signal shows how many seconds you have to finish crossing the intersection. Here is a quick guide on how to use pedestrian signals.

COUNTDOWN SIGNAL – COMING SOON TO A CORNER NEAR YOU
