

## **Section 6. DeIDOT Pond Specifications**

The following specifications were developed to standardize and limit the number of specs being circulated for items pertaining to stormwater management ponds. Accordingly, all new project plans should be developed using these pay items for stormwater management:

<b>Item No.</b>	<b>UOM</b>	<b>Description</b>
271000	CY/(CM <sup>3</sup> )	Stormwater Management Pond
272000 to 272xxx	EA	Pond Outlet Structure, Concrete, Nos. 1-xx
274000	CY/(CM <sup>3</sup> )	Clay Borrow, Type I
274001	CY/(CM <sup>3</sup> )	Clay Borrow, Type II

Pay items 272000 to 272xxx all refer to the same specification. This is because the pond outlet structures are of similar enough design to use the same specs, but are unique enough from pond to pond to result in a range of pricing. Therefore, DeIDOT intends to pay for them under separate pay items. Each pond outlet structure then will have its own pay item number, but refer to a common specification. For instance, if the project has 6 ponds there would be 6 pay items. The ponds would be numbered consecutively from 1-6 and paid under the item numbers starting at 272000 and ending at and including 272005.

There are a total of 6 pay items listed. If a project has more than 6 ponds, the designer only has to continue numbering the ponds consecutively and notify the Specifications Engineer so the appropriate number of pay items may be added to the list.
